The workshop commenced with the introductory address by Dr. Dibakar Datta, TIC, Mathabhanga College. He urged the participants to attract the lessons and advices that were to emerge during the course of the workshop. Dr. Amit Kundu spoke about the understanding of skill development from economical and philosophical point of view. He mentioned Swami Vivekananda's thought on education and inspired the students to assimilate some ideas on character making. He noted that "there are more people than the available jobs at the low skills level, while there are more jobs at the high skills level than those available for such jobs. This demand and supply mismatch indicates that there is a serious mismatch between the education and skills."

Sri Suvopriyo Ghosh, FSM, H.O(ICA) delivered a lecture in motivational session on strategies for increasing student empowerment. Students learned some computer application in practical way. Sri Rajib Dey, Computer faculty of ICA was engaged in that session. Students were mostly benefited. Session 4 was about discussion on placement. Sri Vijoy Kr.Mishra, Placement Executive & PDP faculty, ICA was the speaker of that session. The speakers highlighted the benefits of enrolling at the ICA which would prepare the students for the job-market by conducting mock-interviews as a preparatory drill, as well as offering them practical problems similar to the projects one has to later undertake as employees. The workshop ended with valedictory address by the coordinator of the programme. The workshop on the whole was a great success and the students enjoyed a lot.
